

In January 2001, The Historic Charles Street AME Church and Wellesley Village Church worshipped together at Jordan Hall in Boston. This service was named "Sharing the Dream." Held on the Sunday just before the annual celebration of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr's birth, the service was an active response to his remark "the most segregated hour of Christian America is eleven o'clock on Sunday morning."

Each year since, the "Sharing the Dream" service has been held at one sanctuary or the other, and a deeper and richer partnership between both churches has developed. There have been joint task-forces on several issues of common interest; study groups have explored ways to join in mission; and when one of Village Church's pastors was out on medical leave, a Charles St. pastor served as the "Pastor on Call." To this day, personal friendships between members of both communities have matured and flourished.

This year we are worshipping together in October, in celebration of the 200th birthday of Charles St. Whenever or wherever we gather, both congregations give thanks to God for the chance to worship together as one Body of Christ. Welcome!
