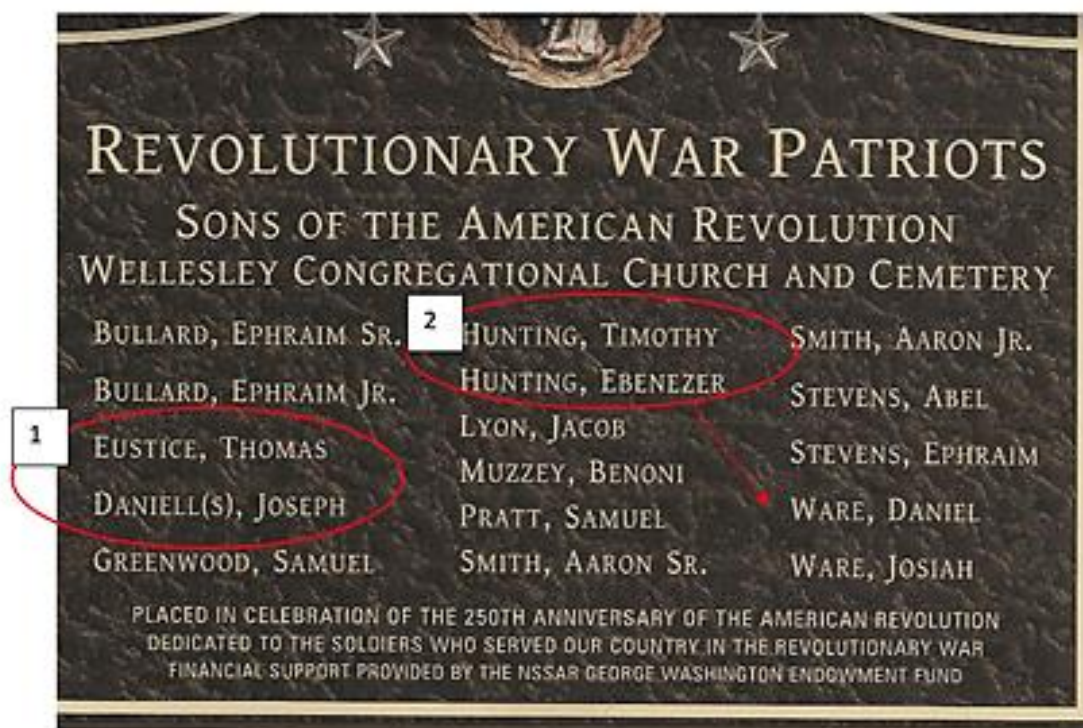


Wellesley Village Church Cemetery – Remember & Honor Veterans of the American Revolution
February 27, 2022 Summary of edit changes to the 1st Draft Proof of the Bronze Plaque

Response from stakeholdier members for the cemetery commemorative plaque, Wellesley Village Church. Please have the CenTec Cast Metal Products provide a revised CAD drawing for final proof acceptance with the following changes:

- 1) Size dimensions – selected the “large” (26-inches wide X 22-inches tall)
- 2) Plaque mounting, eliminate from design the stansion mount at base of the plaque. Change the design to “gromment” holes in the 4-corners. Please have the foundry provide brozen pins for fastening (into either stone or masonry).
- 3) Alphabetical placement of the venteran family surname and first name. Noted below (items #1 and #2), place in alphabetical order. No change “Sr.” shall precede “Jr.”
- 4) Spelling of veteran’s surname. Ebenezer Huntting (note 2 “T”). Confirming “Daniell(s), Joseph” is correct. Historical record indicates 2 spellings (with and without “s” for the surname of the veteran.
- 5) The 2nd draft of the CAD drawing design when ready please send a copy of the file to each Church Historian: Brad Harding (bradharding64@gmail.com) and church/SAR project contact: bradbittenbender (bradbittenbender@yahoo.com). They will follow up on obtaining Wellesley Viliage Church signature for acceptance.



1. Daniel[s], Joseph should be listed above Eustice, Thomas based on last name alphabetical order
2. Hunting, Ebenezer should be listed above Hunting, Timothy based on first name alphabetical order following the example of the Wares, Daniel & Josiah listed in alphabetical order by first name.
